## ORDER

On May 16, 2024, the parties filed a joint motion for a scheduling order under Rule 6 of the Rules of the United States Court of Federal Claims. [ECF 34]. Accordingly, for good cause shown, the Court **GRANTS** the parties' motion and **ADOPTS** the following schedule:

- On or before **June 17, 2024**, the government shall file the administrative record.
- On or before **August 2, 2024**, plaintiffs shall file a motion for judgment on the administrative record.
- On or before **September 17, 2024**, the government shall file a consolidated response to plaintiffs' dispositive motion and cross-motion for judgment on the administrative record.
- On or before **October 22, 2024**, plaintiffs shall file a consolidated response to the government's dispositive cross-motion and reply in support of their dispositive motion.
- On or before **November 12, 2024**, the government shall file its reply to plaintiffs' response to its cross-motion for judgment on the administrative record.
