ORDER

The Court received an email from plaintiffs' counsel on June 29, 2026, expressing concerns regarding "a letter received by one of [the] named plaintiffs" in the case, which referenced a monetary deposit in the named plaintiff's account as a settlement and further stated that the "[u]se of these funds means you accept the settlement, and you have no further claim on the United States that is based on this correction to your military records." Plaintiffs' counsel raised several objections to the letter, requested a status conference, and copied counsel for the United States on the email.

Currently, the Court does not find a status conference necessary. Instead, the Court **ORDERS** the parties to file a joint status report **on or before July 7, 2026**, regarding the referenced letter and addressing the plaintiffs' objections, as appropriate.
